Model of Rogerian Argument:

1.	State the nature of the problem
2.	Summarize the opposition's argument
3.	Recognize what elements of the opposition's argument have merit
4.	Summarize your position.
5.	Demonstrate why your position has merit
6.	Conclude with a proposal that can appeal to the self-interest of both side in the conflict
